WHEN PERSISTENCE BECOMES PROGRESS

Since 2019, one woman turned to the Community Shelter for help 23 times as she navigated homelessness, substance use, and family separation.

Each time, staff welcomed her back and helped her take another step toward stability.

During FY26, she moved into permanent housing, continued strengthening her recovery, and began working toward reunification with her daughter.

Returning for help is not failure.
